Dear colleagues and friends,

Researchers of the Laboratory of Nuclear Reactions and the Laboratory of Theoretical Physics described new characteristics of heavy rutherfordium isotope fission. The experiment was conducted at the U-400 Cyclotron. The data obtained deepen scientists' understanding of the decay mechanisms of transuranic elements and open up new opportunities for studying nuclei near the boundaries of nuclear stability.

The Institute's specialists measured the average number of instantaneous neutrons emitted during spontaneous nuclear fission of rutherfordium-260. The experiment was conducted by FLNR and BLTP specialists at the U-400 Cyclotron using the SHELS Separator and the SFINx Detection System.

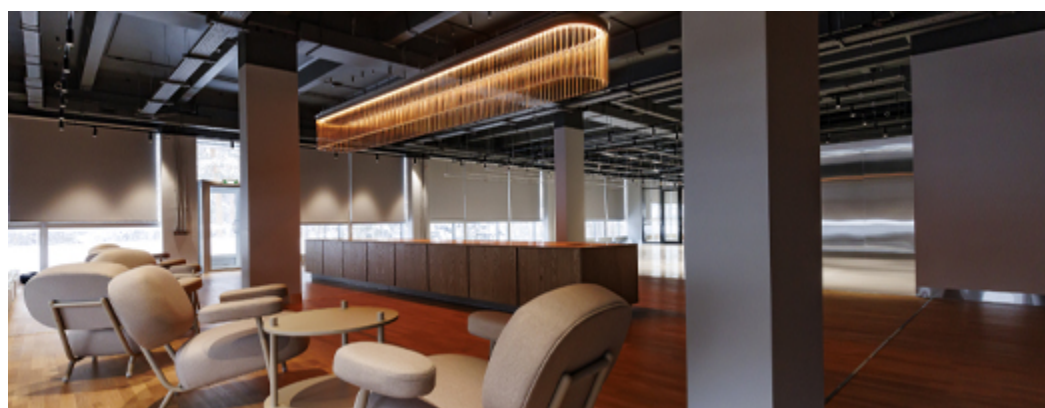
